These tools are built into your test. Use them to show what you know!

Universal Tools (Always Available)

Tool Name	What it looks like	How to use it
Pointer	Arrow icon	Your "home base." Use it to select answers and move to the next page.
Highlighter	Marker icon	Highlight important words in the question or passage to stay focused.
Cross-Off	Red "X" icon	Click an answer choice to "eliminate" it if you know it's wrong.
Sticky Note	Yellow square	Type notes to yourself (like "Check this later!") on any page.
Magnifier	Glass with a +	Zoom in on images or small text if you need to see them better.
Line Guide	Horizontal line	Use this to focus on one line of text at a time so you don't skip anything.
Masking	Grey box icon	Use this to cover up parts of the screen so you can focus on one section.

Math & Science Specific Tools (Grade 5)

- **Four-Function Calculator:** Available only during specific Math sessions. It has basic buttons (+, -, x, ÷) and a square root (\sqrt{x}) button.
- **Reference Sheet:** A digital sheet with formulas (like volume or area) and measurement conversions.
- **Equation Builder:** A special keyboard that pops up when you need to type math symbols or fractions into an answer box.
- **Protractor & Ruler:** Drag these digital tools over images to measure angles or lengths for specific math questions.

Pro-Tips for Using the Tools

- **Flag for Review:** If a question is taking too long, click the **Flag** icon. This puts a reminder on your Review Screen so you can come back to it at the end without losing time.
- **The Review Screen:** Before you submit your test, you will see a screen showing every question number. A yellow circle means you didn't finish it; a flag means you wanted to check it again.
- **Practice First:** You can try all of these tools right now in the **Online Tools Training (OTT)**. It looks exactly like the real test, but none of the answers count!
